





### Water-Saving Checklist

### **Sprinklers**



Alert. o to scwd.org/conservation for info.



Turn off sprinklers when it rains. Save 15-20 gallons per minute.

Fix leaky or broken sprinklers immediately.

Save 15-20 gallons per day. Turn off sprinklers during repairs.

Adjust sprinklers watering pavement. Save 15-25 gals per day.

Replace grass with CA-friendly plants or synthetic turf.

Save 30-60 gallons per day per 1,000 sq ft.

Use 2"-3" of mulch. Save 20-30 gallons per day per 1,000 sq ft.

Install weather-based sprinkler controllers.

Save 20-40 gallons per day per 1,000 sq ft.

#### Outdoors

Sweep paved areas—don't hose. Save 10-15 gallons per minute.

Fix leaky hose bibs and pool/spa pumps immediately.

Save 15-20 gallons per day.

Use pool and spa covers. Save up to 30 gallons per day.

Go to a commercial car wash—the wash water is recycled.

Save 200+ gallons per wash.
