## Governor Brown Issues Executive Order Mandatory 25% Potable Water Reduction District Declares Level 2 Water Supply Warning

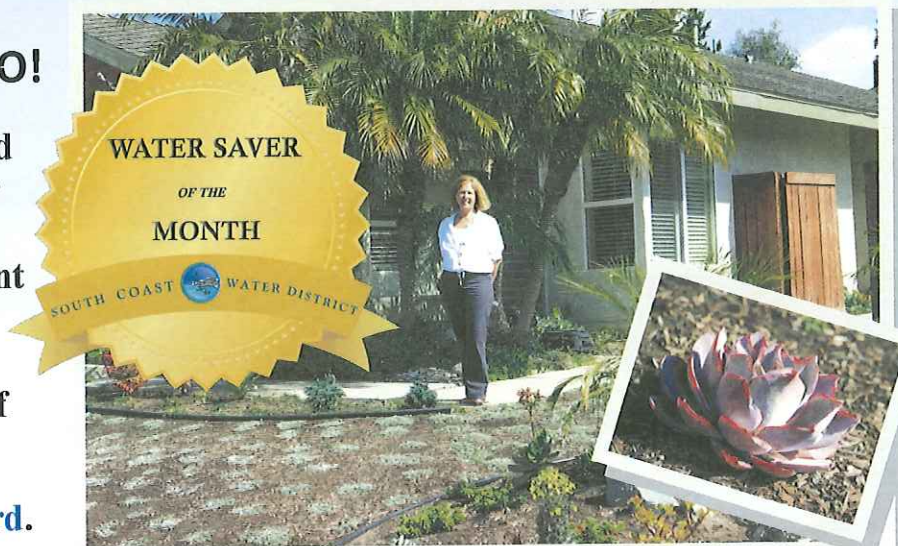
### Water Conservation Regulations Update

- ☒ Limit landscape irrigation to 1 day per week between 5 p.m. and 9 a.m.
- ☒ No filling or refilling of ornamental lakes or ponds
- ☒ Residential watering day: Monday  
Business, HOA, gov't, school: Wednesday
- ☒ No filling or refilling of residential pools or spas
- ☒ Limit watering to 10 minutes per sprinkler station/zone, with no run-off
- ☒ No hosing down or washing vehicles
- ☒ Repair leaks within 2 business days
- ☒ Golf courses must irrigate with recycled water if District determines cost effective
- ☒ New construction of homes and buildings must use drip or micro-spray system for outside irrigation, except when using recycled water.
- ☒ New multi-unit residences must have an individual water meter for each unit.
- ☒ Use of potable water to irrigate ornamental turf on public street medians is prohibited.

### WHAT YOU CAN DO, TOO!

Congratulations to Donna and Henry Scimia, winners of our first **\$500 Water Saver of the Month Award!** The Dara Point residents replaced turf with California-friendly plants, saving about 25,000 gallons of potable water per year.

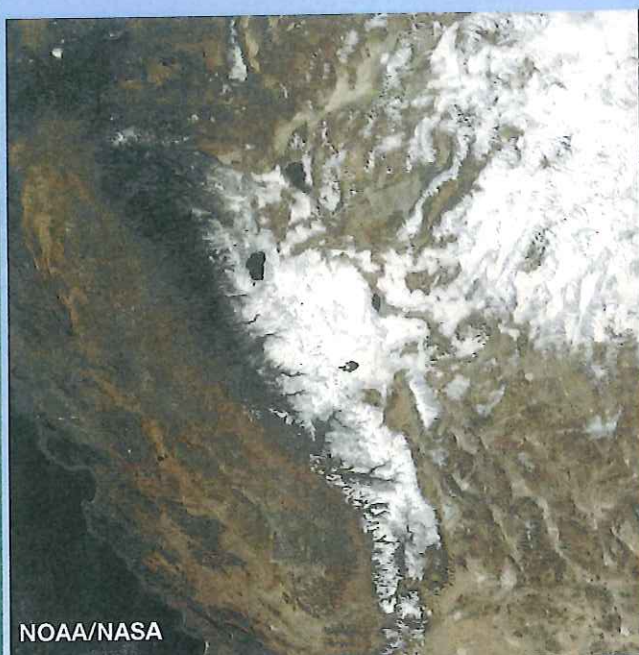
