September activities are now being planned, and your Board will welcome suggestions for the fall programs at the next meeting on September 5th,.





#### SAUNAS

The saunas are now open in both the mens and womens locker rooms. They are being kept at 185000, Please observe the following rules while enjoying your S sauna:

## - - - SAUNA PRECAUTIONS - - -

- 1. All persons must be 18 years or older to use the saunas
- 2. The following satergories of personal medical backgrounds are <u>not</u> to use sauna:
  - A. Heart patients, stroke victims, or history of cardiovascular ailments
  - B. Depilepsy truck almos bus long extentive transmit
  - C. Diabetics or hypoglycemic persons
  - D. Recent head injury
  - E. Under the influence or control of alcohol or drugs
  - F. When feverish or suffering from contagious illness

#### HOW TO USE

- A. Sauna baths are to be taken in three stages with each sauna bath lasting no more than 10 minutes.
  - B. After each 10 minute sauna bath, a "cool" shower should be taken,. Before taking a second and third sauna bath you should rest at least 10 minutes.
  - C. For your comfort and convenience a towel may be placed over the hot redwood benches, bathing suits may be worn if preferred.
  - D. Overheating precautions are shortness of breath, rapid heavy pulse, dryness of mouth, and dizzyness. Sauna cycles should be discontinued when these signs occur.
  - E. Enjoy your sauna and good health!
