As a valued customer of Harvest Landscape I want to introduce you to section 6618- "Notice of Application" stated in the California Code of Regulations (CCR), which requires Homeowners Associations to notify its members when and where pesticides are being applied. As your landscape provider we are responsible for providing copies of the Material Safety Data Sheets (MSDS). These provide detailed information on each hazardous chemical, including its potential hazardous effects, physical, and chemical characteristics, and recommendations for appropriate measures.

Harvest Landscape will post up signs when pesticides are being applied and will notify the Property Manager at least five (5) business days prior to the pesticide application, in turn the HOA should inform its member. This can be done in form of a newsletter or memo.

I have attached the copies of MSDS that we regularly use and suggest these be kept at the HOA's management office, be sent to all board members or be posted in a designated posting area at each HOA managed by your company.

Harvest Landscape will ensure that the HOA complies with Section 6618 by taking all necessary precautions when applying pesticides.
