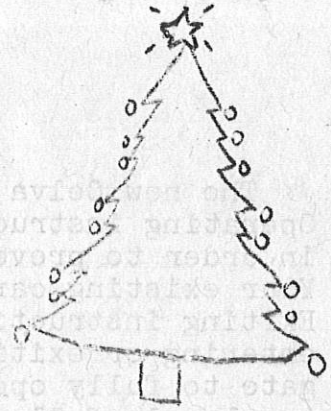

SELVA ROAD GATES

The new Selva Road Automatic Iron Gate system is now in use. Operating instructions are simple but should be closely followed in order to prevent damage to both the mechanism and your car. Your existing card key will allow you to enter from Selva Road. Exiting instructions are posted at the gate. Remember while entering or exiting always come to a complete stop and allow the gate to fully open before passing through. If you should attempt to closely follow the vehicle in front of you through, possible damage could occur to your car and the gate equipment. Also parents please instruct your children not to play around the gate nor most important not to swing on the gates or ride them while they are in operation. This is very dangerous, and if anyone should see this happening, please warn the children and report it to the Recreation Center office (493-0122). Due to possible vandalism during the late or early morning hours, gate operating times have been established from 7 A.M. to 10 P.M. seven days a week. Please use the gates carefully and report any adverse conditions.

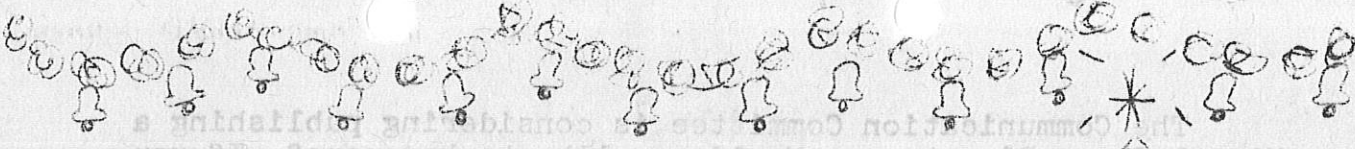
All men who reside in Niguel Shores Communities are invited to join us at breakfast the first, third, and fifth Tuesdays of each month in the Center.

NIGUEL SHORES MEN'S GOLF

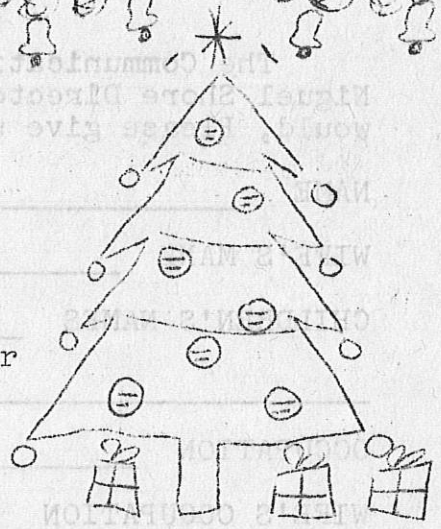

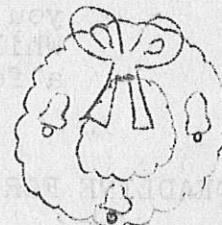

CAUTION: CHILDREN AT PLAY



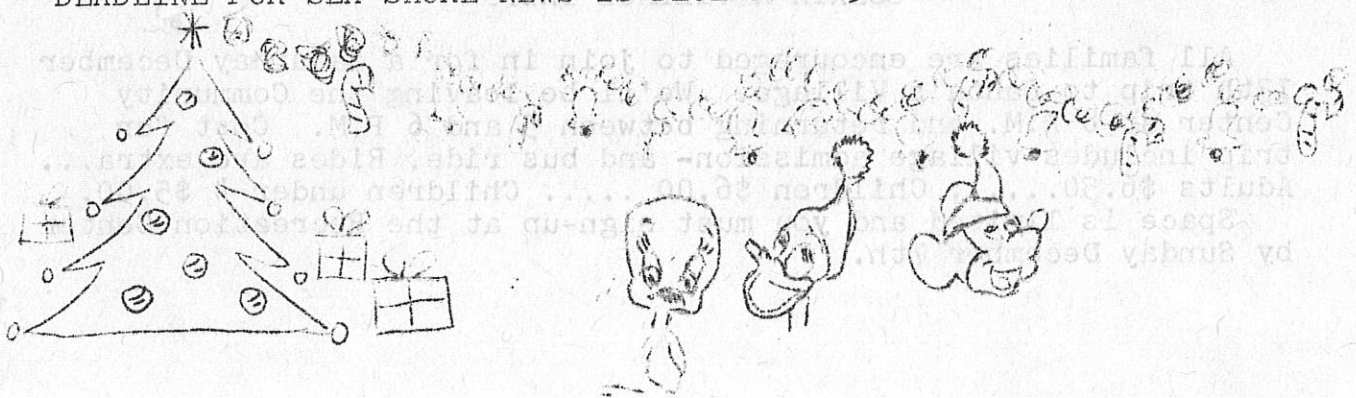
There are no signs depicting areas where children should or should not play, consequently we must be aware of them at all times. These tiny ones are an asset to our community and we don't want to lose them due to hazardous circumstances. Don't be the cause, either directly or indirectly, of a tragic mishap involving a child. Little people are so short to be seen and can easily be in front or behind your parked car.

Our sidewalks are frequently used as roads by the little trikers and bikers. By blocking this pathway with your car, they will be detoured into the streets where fast moving traffic is not uncommon. Children on the sidewalks and autos on the streets: If the two are mixed, it can be fatal. By following four safety precautions, a child's life can be spared.

1. Don't park on or block the sidewalks.
2. Don't drive on the sidewalks.
3. Drive cautiously!
4. Be extremely watchful for children at play.

How would you feel if you were responsible for a child's injury? While there has been an improvement there are still a few violators. Please cooperate.

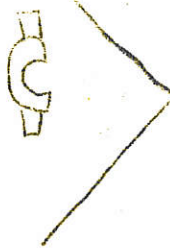
