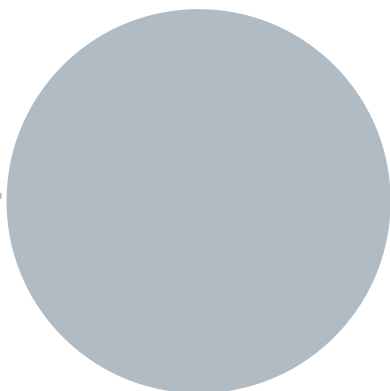


WATER CONSERVATION NOTICE

RESIDENTIAL



LEVEL 2 WATER SUPPLY SHORTAGE

- Customers **must repair leaks**, breaks, and malfunctions (i.e., faulty sprinklers) **within three (3) business days** of District notification.
- Landscape **irrigation shall be limited to three (3) days per week from April – October** and **one (1) day per week from November - March** (Watering Schedule on Back, subject to change without notice)
- **Watering, or irrigating, is prohibited between 9am and 5pm** (this applies to lawns, landscaping, and all other vegetated areas).
- Watering, or irrigating, with a device or irrigation system, is limited to **no more than 10 minutes per valve, per cycle**.
- **Outdoor watering CANNOT result in runoff.** The application of Potable (Drinking) Water to outdoor landscapes shall not cause runoff such that water flows onto adjacent property, non-irrigated areas, private and public walkways, roadways, parking lots, or structures.
- Pools and Spas require a cover when not in use.

These restrictions do NOT apply to Recycled Water Users (HOAs, Parks, Schools, Golf Courses, etc. indicated by purple signage)

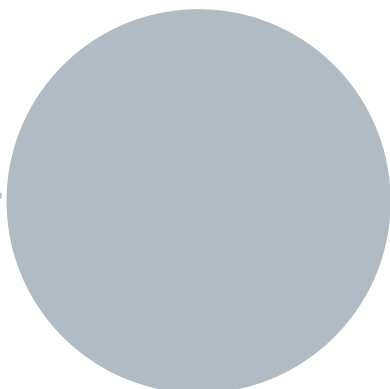

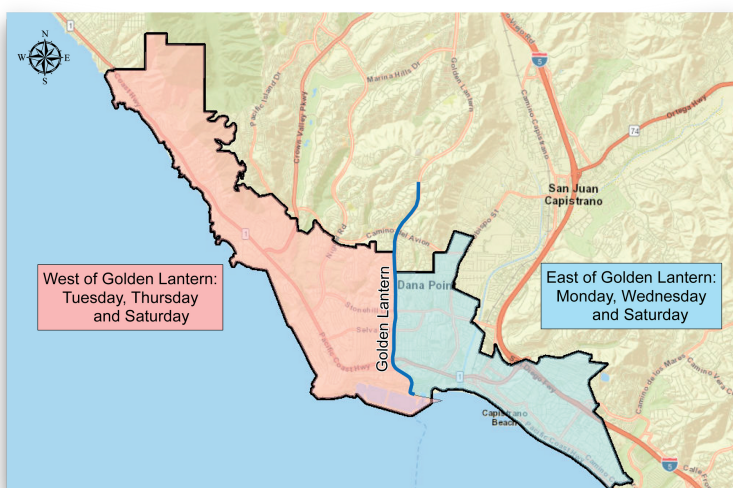

THREE (3) Day A Week Sprinkler/Irrigation Schedule



LEVEL 2 - WATER SUPPLY SHORTAGE

Run your sprinkler system **only** on designated day before 9AM or after 5PM (prohibited from 9AM to 5PM), **with no runoff**.

Residential Watering Days

WEST of Golden Lantern, water on:
TUESDAY, THURSDAY, SATURDAY

EAST of Golden Lantern, water on:
MONDAY, WEDNESDAY, SATURDAY
